Foster Home Contract for Dog _____ # _____

1. Dogs in the Patriot Assistance Dogs (PAD) program are the property of PAD. Individuals participating agree to abide by the rules and training guidelines set forth by this contract and any subsequent training materials provided. **Initials** _____
2. Should a dispute arise, the foster agree that all court proceedings will be held in the Becker County Court District, in Detroit Lakes MN. **Initials** _____
3. PAD will provide veterinary care/expenses and food for the fostered dog. If the foster home is capable of providing those items and claim a corresponding tax deduction, please initial here. _____ A flat buckle collar with identification tag, a training collar, a six foot leather leash, initial chew toys and specific training equipment will be provided by PAD. Any leashes or training equipment lost, damaged or destroyed must be replaced by the foster with same quality items. **Initials** _____
4. Foster participants will provide a crate of suitable size for the dog. All dogs used in the program must be crate trained. **Initials** _____
5. The foster agrees to keep the dog clean and groomed (to include teeth, ears and nails), and to immediately report to PAD any injuries or abnormalities in the dog.

6. The foster agrees to keep the dog contained at all times. Dogs in the PAD program may not be allowed to run at large. PAD dogs are allowed off leash out of doors only if directly supervised and contained in a securely fenced area. If the dog goes missing, the loss must be reported to the trainer or PAD training program supervisor within one hour. **Initials** _____
7. The dog must be a house dog and must be kept crated inside when no one is home to supervise. Any damage done by a dog left unsupervised will be the foster's responsibility. **Initials** _____
8. PAD will pay for daycare, day boarding, or overnight boarding on a case by case basis. These services must be at a facility approved by and pre-authorized by the PAD trainer.

9. The foster may be required to attend regular classes with the dog to prepare it for future service. Training for individual dogs will be determined by the PAD trainer and the foster. **Initials** _____
10. The foster will be encouraged to train with the dog and complete the AKC's Canine Good Citizen program. PAD will pay for the class fees and evaluations for Canine Good Citizen. CGC Schedule: _____ **Initials** _____

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11. The foster agrees to keep records and file reports as provided by the PAD program coordinator. **Initials**_____
12. The foster must make the dog available for inspection, evaluation or for medical treatment within 24 hours of request by PAD personnel. **Initials**_____
13. Should the dog not successfully complete the PAD program, the dog will be placed in PAD's Started Dog Program. The primary foster for that dog will have the first option to purchase the dog at a negotiated price (assuming the foster is in good standing with PAD.) **Initials**_____
14. The foster may opt out of the program at any time by returning the dog and all issued equipment to PAD. **Initials**_____
15. Failure to abide by any portion of this contract is grounds for PAD personnel to remove the dog from the foster. PAD reserves the right to recall the dog at any time.
